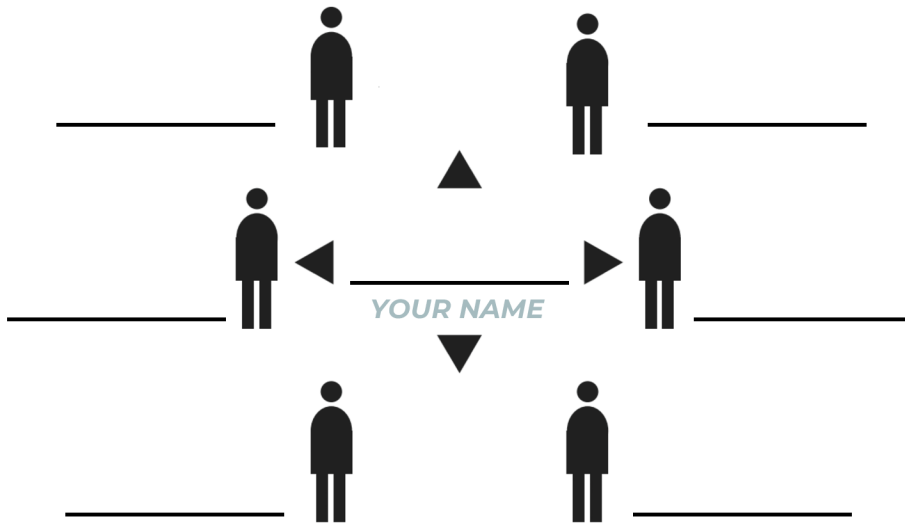

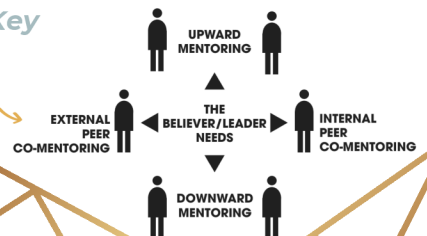

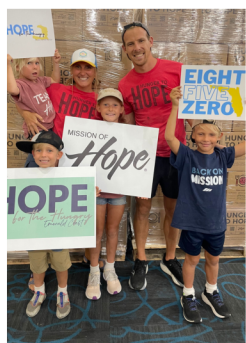


## MISSION OF HOPE

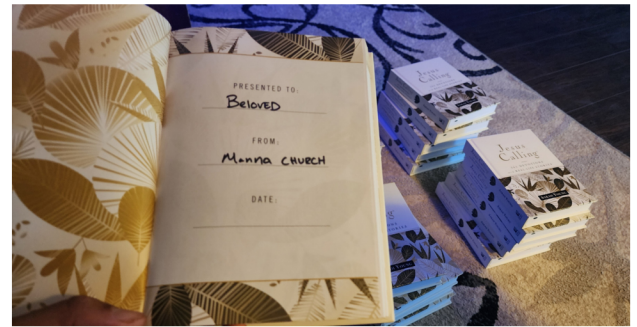

## AIRMENS ATTIC

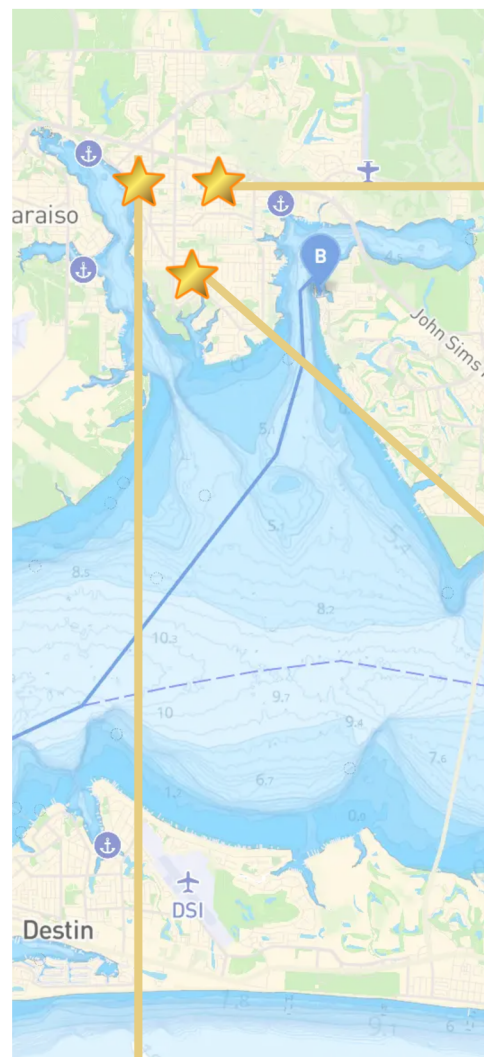

# WEEK 2

## Action Plan: Your Faith

Action plans help you start. Commitments help you continue. Let's get started this week on cultivating a deeper faith through small steps of obedience.

### Memorize Matthew 28:18-20

#### Memorization tips:

- Write the scripture down on a post-it and hang it somewhere you'll see every day (the sink, bathroom mirror)
- Dive into the meaning of the scripture. A great resource to do this is Bible Hub.
- In his book 'Meditation', Jim Bowning talked about how our brains meditate all night on the last thing we think about before we fall asleep. Read this scripture a few times before heading to bed and see how it soaks into your heart.
- You write out the verse using only the first letter of each word, along with punctuation and verse reference. This creates a memory scaffold that helps your brain recall the entire word.

Make a list of those you can pray for daily, and place their names on the bookmark on the back page of this workbook. Cut it out and use it as a bookmark in your Bible.

Who is God putting on your heart to spend more time hanging out with? What's your next step?

Who do you know who is sick or injured that you can pray for? Make it a point to pray for their healing the next time you see them. Stretch your faith!

If you haven't already, attend First Step to prepare Your Story (or review your notes) to share with those who ask "for the reason for the hope that you have." (1 Peter 3:15)

# FROM THE MISSION FIELD...

The Mission trip to Albania in Spring 2025 was an incredible experience from start to finish. The planning and preparation process that Manna Church has in place really prepared us for what to expect during travel, when we arrived, and during our time in-country. The coordinator, Justin Humphreys, and his wife Katie, spent a lot of time discussing the cultural differences that the team would be exposed to while in-country and this preparation was invaluable.



None of us on the team knew for sure what would happen, but seeing and experiencing what Justin and Katie described really helped lessen the culture shock of traveling from NW Florida to Greece and then Albania. Working together with the local Albanian church and seeing their faith in action was inspirational for all of us. Seeing God move His people to the right place at the right time is always awesome to watch happen in real time.



Communism ended in Albania in the early 1990s – and the religious impacts remain visible today. Most Americans have some idea of the religious stories contained in the Bible or a conceptual idea of who God is. As a result of Communism and its after-effects, many Albanians have been exposed to little (if any) any Christian teachings. This absence of God has made many hungry for the hope that only Jesus offers. The New Heights Church in Elbasan is working hard every day to foster relationships, spread the Gospel and demonstrate the love of Christ. It's really encouraging to know that Manna Church West Florida is helping to support such a Spirit-led church as it works to move God's Kingdom forward.

\$10 pays for a toiletry kit for the youth, many of whom do not have safe running water in their homes.



\$1,000 will pay for a load of gravel for the road on our land on Pine Ridge where we are building an Opportunity Center and an outdoor stage for Christian artists to come and worship in the community.



\$150 pays for one entire show - an hour of Christian teaching to travel the airwaves all over Pine Ridge AND to be streamed nationwide.

## HOOR OF HARVEST: BRAZIL



\$100 a month can support an indigenous missionary



\$40 provides an emergency food basket



\$250 will provide a sewing machine for the church women to share.



\$1000 to buy hunting equipment needed for safety and food.



## FRONTLINE MISSIONS: COLOMBIA AND VENEZUELA



\$1,000 buys land for a safe house in Colombia for the indigenous tribes who have converted to Christianity and have been kicked out of their village.



\$50 buys a month of gas for evangelists to visit remote villages in Colombia.



\$100 a month funds rent for a church building in Venezuela.

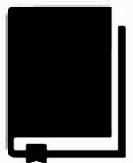
